

EXHIBIT C – EMERGENCY CALL PROCEDURES

In the event that an emergency needs to be reported due to any of the following:

- A signalized intersection has gone into all red flash,
- A light pole listing or posing a direct hazard to public safety,
- A signal pole listing or posing a direct hazard to public safety, or
- Other incidents that require immediate action be taken by MnDOT Maintenance forces.

It is the responsibility of the contractor to immediately notify MnDOT Dispatch at 651-234-7110 (24/7) to report the event. Have the following information available:

- Traffic Signals
 - Signal system ID
 - Trunk highway number
 - Intersecting cross street name
 - City name
- Light Poles
 - Pole number as it is on the pole (example A4F-2)
 - Trunk highway number
 - Closest cross street or mile point
 - City name
 - Direction of travel of the pole (North, South, East or West bound)

In addition, the contractor will notify Michael Gerbensky at 651-234-7816. If unavailable leave a message with a brief description of the event, name, and call back number.
