The MN County Engineers Association (MCEA) is making available several documents related to the voluntary Monarch Candidate Conservation Agreement with Assurances (Monarch CCAA) for the purpose of assisting other counties in Minnesota who are considering, or in process of, applying to become Monarch CCAA partners.

Please note:

1. Although we have posted the Monarch CCAA and a few other UIC documents on this web site there is no guarantee they are the most recent versions.
2. Example applications are intended to provide ideas for how an applicant might respond to the questions; however, every county's application will be unique. It is important that each applicant tailor their responses to fit their own situation.

Also note that, as of February 2021, none of the draft county applications provided have completed the review process. We will try to replace these first draft applications with the final, approved version along with notes explaining deficiencies identified by the reviewers. It is the MCEA Monarch Committee's goal to eventually provide several sample applications that are representative of different regions of the state, land covers and land uses.
