Seek Clarification/More info:

- Pg 112, 113: top table shades of blue too similar – vision impairment issue?
- Pg 118: two weeks long enough for sufficient survey results?

Grammar/Accessibility:

- Pg 88-89: Place table on a single page?
- Table 52 font difficult to read (line2)
- Appendix if not going to include ALL transit schedules don't include any

- Pg 26: Senior values and percents should be:

Benton - 5,527 13.77%

Stearns - 23,088 14.57%

- Pg 29: Total populations are different than other tables here (and incorrect). Should be:

Benton: 40,129

Stearns: 158,452

Sherburne: 94,463

Wright: 134,438

Percentages incorrect. Should be:

Benton: 11.52%

Stearns: 10.67%

Sherburne: 8.91%

Wright: 9.42%

- Pg 32:

This table doesn't include population for children under 5 years - the data we shared does. I think this table should be revisited to include pop. under 5.

- Pg 34:

This table doesn't have the correct total adult population or percentages. They should be:

Benton: 24,458 - 9.71%

Stearns: 98,706 - 8.85%

Sherburne: 59,039 - 7.34%

Wright: 80,256 - 7.41%

- Pg 36:

The senior population totals are incorrect so the percentages are too. Should be:

Benton: 5,527 - 33.62%

Stearns: 23,088 - 31.14%

Sherburne: 10,261 - 29.80%

Wright: 16,361 - 31.75%
