Temporary Portable Precast Concrete Barrier Anchorage to Glued-Laminated Wood Panel (Temporary Usage in Limited Barrier Displacement Areas)

Approved, and signed, April 9, 2020. Last date revised: December 2, 2020.

Revised 12-02-2020

At ANCHORAGE DETAILS:

- Changed the dimension line from “3’-0” Max. Overhang” to “3’-0” Max.”.
- Added dimension line “7’-0” Max. Overhang (4)” from the CL fascia beam to the edge of deck. This moves the edge of deck outside of both the deflection distance and the 6” max. from the edge of risers.

Under NOTES:

- Added “(4) Loading is limited to the self-weight of the overhang components shown, plus a maximum construction load of 20 psf applied to the area between the back bottom edge of the portable barrier and the edge of deck.”
