Description:	<p>This 2 day course will cover the duties and responsibilities of a concrete paving (field and plant) inspector.</p> <p>Topics covered on Day 1: Introduction to concrete paving, staking, surveying, paving joint layouts, pre-production operations, pre-paving operations, and placement operations (8am-4:30pm).</p> <p>Topics covered on Day 2 (AM): Post-placement operations, sawing, sealing, opening to traffic, ride (smoothness), defective work, and troubleshooting (8am-12pm).</p> <p>Topics covered on Day 2 (PM): Concrete Batch Plant monitoring (1pm-4:30pm). Attendees may choose to stay or leave depending on their interest in this specialized topic.</p>
Learning Objectives	When completed the participants will be better able to understand the issues and duties of concrete paving.
