2022 Active Transportation (AT) Infrastructure Solicitation Applications Summary

Summary of Applications Received

A total of \$3.5 million was available for the 2022 AT Infrastructure solicitation. 81 applications were submitted with requests for \$29.5 million in AT infrastructure funding. Applications for this solicitation were separated into five funding pools as described below. On March 6, 2023, the AT Infrastructure Advisory Committee, representing local public organizations and tribal lands statewide, convened, and approved 9 projects for funding through the competitive AT infrastructure solicitation. Please note that the total amount of grant funding awarded in each funding pool was not based on the total number of applications received for each funding pool. Grant awards are equal to the amount requested by each awarded applicant, except for one Major MN City*.

Funding pools:

- Major MN Cities (Minneapolis, Saint Paul, Rochester, & Duluth)
- Metro District Communities (excluding Minneapolis & Saint Paul)
- Greater MN State Aid Cities (excluding Duluth & Rochester)
- Greater MN Small Cities & Townships
- Federally Recognized Tribes³
