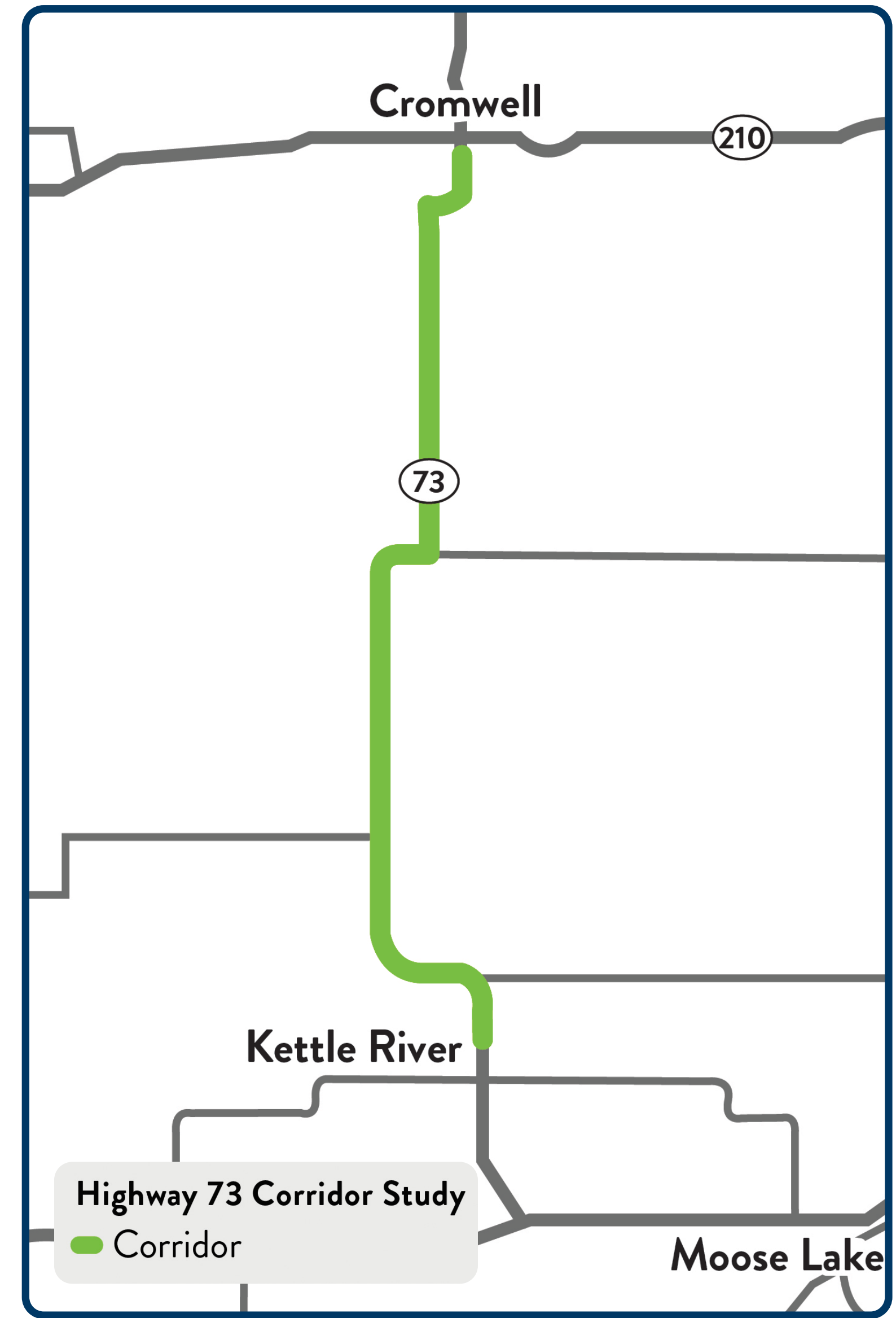


About the Project

- The purpose of this study is to **identify the issues and concerns** with the Hwy 73 Corridor between Kettle River and Cromwell.
- The design team will evaluate the identified issues and develop a range of potential improvements.
- There is **not currently a funded project** to make improvements on Hwy 73. This study will allow the state and local representatives to seek funding for the future improvements.



How will the team identify where the issues exist within the corridor?

- Crash History Analysis
- Public Feedback
- Design Analysis (identifying any sub-standard elements of the highway design)
