

Hwy 48 Hinckley Corridor Study



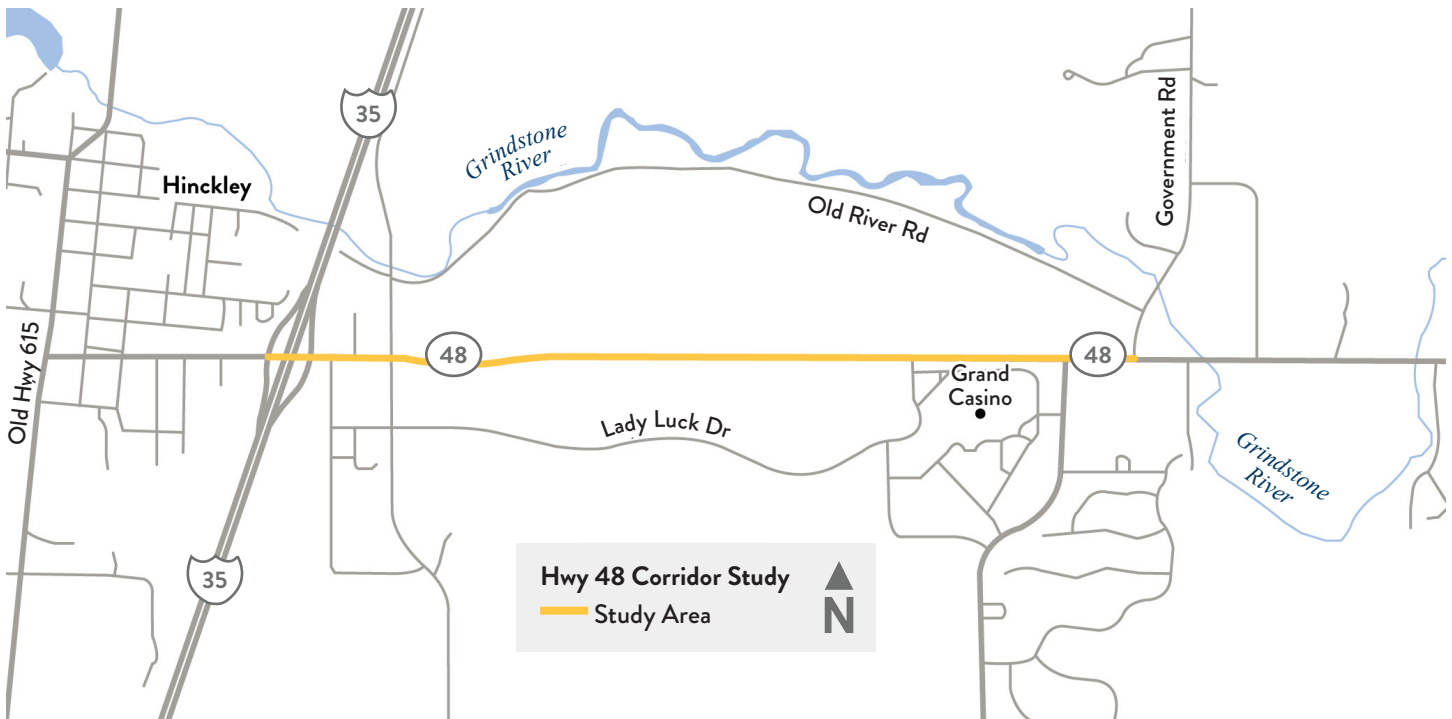
The state is studying Hwy 48 from the west I-35 ramps to Government Road in Hinckley.

Hwy 48 connects local travelers as well as visitors from throughout the region with popular destinations in Hinckley and beyond. The corridor faces safety and congestion challenges, particularly during the summer and fall seasons when weekend traffic is especially high. The corridor is heavily utilized, with more than 25 intersections and driveways, several major traffic generators, and continued growth and development. Following the anticipated schedule below, this study will establish a vision for Hwy 48 and recommend future improvements that can be implemented as funding is available.
