

2023 Local Road Improvement Program Summary

The Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) provides funding assistance to counties, state aid cities, non-state aid cities, townships, and Federally Recognized Indian Tribes for construction, reconstruction, or reconditioning projects.

This document summarizes LRIP funding from the 2023 legislative session transportation omnibus bill ([Chapter 68 - MN Laws](#)) and two capital investment/bonding bills ([Chapter 71 - MN Laws](#) and [Chapter 72 - MN Laws](#)), resulting in a combined total appropriation of \$102.967 million. This consists of \$84.954 million in general obligation bond funds and \$18.013 million in general funds, of which at least \$6 million must be for grants to townships for the competitive LRIP. An additional \$235.56 million was legislatively selected for 38 local projects. Please contact State Aid for more information on these projects.

The competitive LRIP solicitation was released on September 12, 2023. Applications were due on December 8, 2023. We received 378 application submittals with total cost estimates of \$921.9 million, with requests of \$417.1 million in LRIP funding. On March 14, 2024, the LRIP Advisory Committee, as identified in [Sec. 174.52 MN Statutes](#) Subd. 3, convened and approved 86 projects for funding through the competitive LRIP solicitation. Table 1 is a summary of selections by entity type.
