The attached Standard Plates have been given initial approval by the FHWA and may now be referenced by their appropriate number in the plans. A brief description of the plates are covered below.

7000 E Integrant Curbs

7102 F Concrete Curb and Gutter

An error depicting the Design D curb, and curb and gutter was made on Standard Plates 7000 D and 7102 E. The correct configurations are shown on the new plates

8002 D Permanent Barricade

At the time the wooden elements for the barricade were reduced, a reduction in length of connecting bolts was not made. A local supplier requested that the bolt lengths be reduced to 1/2" x 7" rather than 1/2" x 8" bolts, and 1/2" x 6" rather 1/2" x 7" bolts. These bolt sizes were changed on this plate.

1. Remove 7000 D (Backside 7020 G), 7100 D (Backside 7102 E) and 8000 D (Backside 8002 C).
2. Insert 7000 E (Backside 7020 G), 7100 D (Backside 7102 F) and 8000 D (Backside 8002 D).
